Jeff was native to Upper Arlington and then lived in Dublin for the past 35 years. He graduated with his Bachelor's Degree from Wittenberg University, attended Medical School at The Ohio State University, and served his residency at Riverside Methodist Hospital. Jeff continued to serve the community as a Family Practice Physician for 35 years. Jeff's greatest joy was his family. He was a golfer at Scioto Country Club, an avid OSU football fan, and loved golden retrievers, specifically, Archie. His family will especially remember his love for life and his ability to make people laugh. He taught them that life's problems could be solved surrounded by loved ones with a cold Heineken and a good belly laugh. Jeff was a beloved husband, father, physician, and friend to many.
