



## Marcedius "Ted" Jameson

January 23, 1962 - September 17, 2019

Marcedius Theodore "Ted" Jameson of Lawrenceville, NJ, was called home on Tuesday, September 17, 2019 after spending a joyous weekend with family, friends and football! Ted was born in Columbus, GA but called Columbus, OH home. He attended Whetstone High School and then went on to attend Ohio Wesleyan University, majoring in Math and Physics. As a student-athlete in high school and in college, Ted played many sports including tennis, baseball and swimming, with his passion being football. On the field, Ted contributed in many positions, leading his team as a quarterback in high school and hitting hard as a strong safety and linebacker in college ("Hit Man"). Ted was inducted into Ohio Wesleyan's Hall of Fame in 2002 and received prestigious awards as both a student and alumni. If you knew Ted, you know he felt the student and athlete parts of the phrase were equally important to him. Ted received his master degree in Environmental Engineering from New Jersey Institute of Technology and continued to keep fit and trim, even working out on vacations. Ted began his professional career at Proctor and Gamble as a Field Advisory Representative. He then transitioned to the Department of Environmental Protection as a Site Manager. Ted worked his way through various supervisory positions until his recent retirement as Director for Water and Land Use Enforcement. During his tenure, Ted continued his professional education, certification and training, and worked on many projects of substantial impact in New Jersey. Ted was a proud member of BEST (Black Environmental Solidarity Team) since 1992. Outside of work, Ted was a member of both Tabernacle Baptist and Shiloh Baptist Church. Ted also coached youth football starting in Ewing (1993 - 2007), Lawrence (2008-2010) and Hopewell (2010 - 2017). Once a coach, always a coach, so in addition to football, you could also find Ted supporting every activity in which his children became involved. Ted was a handyman, loved staying fit, coach, mentor, Cleveland Browns and Ohio State Buckeyes fan. Ted is predeceased in death by his father George Jameson, uncle Lewis Griffin and survived by his mother Norma Jameson, wife of 18 years, Amye Jameson, children Alexis, Marcedius Alexander, Tedi and Tyler, granddaughter Riley, siblings Dorothy Adams, Jacqueline Conner (Brian), Brian Jameson (Sherelle); Otis Williams and additional siblings Shari Tarpley, Shirl Fields, Laren Williams and Kent Butts, as well as a slew of nieces and nephews that he counted as his own.
